
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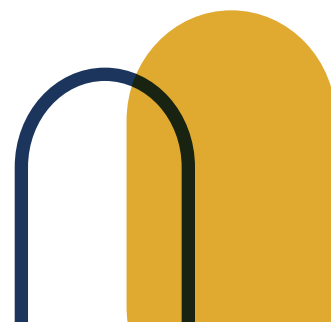
Director General Message

Earning the ACS in Accounting and Business Management opens the door to a variety of positions, including:

- Accounting Clerk (NOC 14200);
- Accounts Receivable Clerk;
- Bookkeeping Clerk
- Accounting Technician (NOC 12200);
- Administrative Assistant – Finance;
- Budget Management Technician;

Languages and Duration

This program is offered in French and English. The total duration of the program is **495 hours**.

The Accounting and Business Management program is designed for individuals who wish to develop versatile expertise in accounting, taxation, finance, and the management of administrative operations. This comprehensive program enables learners to acquire the technical and professional skills in demand within small, medium, and large enterprises, as well as in the public sector and non-profit organizations.

Structured around specialized courses and practical workshops, the program provides the tools to master the entire accounting cycle, produce financial analyses, use accounting software, and contribute to strategic and budget planning. This program is offered in French and English and leads to an Attestation of College Studies (ACS) recognized by the ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur.

The program trains professionals to support accounting and administration, contributing to an organization's financial success. Graduates will be able to:

- Record all financial transactions and prepare financial statements;
- Analyze and process data throughout the accounting cycle;
- Manage accounts payable, accounts receivable, and payroll;
- Use accounting, tax, and office software effectively;
- Advise management on profitability, financing strategies, and tax compliance;
- Ensure adherence to legal and regulatory obligations

With an ACS, graduates qualify for roles like insurance agents and brokers (NOC 63100), selling various insurance products to individuals and organizations. They may work for insurers, brokerage firms, or independently. Related job titles include:

- Insurance Agent
- Insurance Sales Manager
- Insurance Broker
- Insurance Representative

The Insurance and Financial Services Consulting program equips students with practical skills for careers in insurance and finance. Through specialized courses, simulations, and a 4-week internship, students gain hands-on knowledge in insurance, taxation, savings, credit, and the profession's legal and ethical standards.

This program is offered over four semesters and leads to an Attestation of College Studies (ACS) recognized by the ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur. It is available in both French and English.

Languages and Duration

This program is offered in French and English. The total duration of the program is **1,605 hours**.

The program trains consultants to offer expert, compliant advice and manage client relationships effectively. Graduates will be able to:

- Analyze insurance, credit, and savings needs of individuals and businesses;
- Recommend and sell financial products and insurance policies that meet legal requirements and client needs;
- Interpret financial statements, produce financial analyses, and assess the tax implications of various decisions;
- Use technological tools, including customer relationship management (CRM) software, in compliance with confidentiality and security regulations;
- Communicate fluently in French and English in a professional context;



Mortgage Brokerage

(EEC.2H)

Attestation of College Studies (ACS)

Career Opportunities



The Mortgage Brokerage ACS prepares graduates to practice as mortgage brokers under the supervision of the Autorité des marchés financiers (AMF). Completing the ACS allows graduates to sit for the AMF certification exams and begin the mandatory 12-week probationary period.

Languages and Duration

This program is offered in French and English. The total duration of the program is **285 hours**.

The Mortgage Brokerage (EEC.2H) program is designed for individuals who wish to acquire the knowledge, skills, and professional ethics required to practice as a mortgage broker in Québec. This program is fully aligned with the requirements of the Autorité des marchés financiers (AMF), which regulates this profession and defines the mandatory curriculum.

The program emphasizes mastering legal and ethical rules, developing financial analysis skills, and learning the professional practices needed to advise a diverse clientele on both residential and commercial mortgages.

The program is offered in French and English and leads to an Attestation of College Studies (ACS) recognized by the ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur.

The program aims to train competent mortgage brokers who are able to:

- Establish a professional practice that complies with current regulations and the highest ethical standards;
- Carry out mortgage brokerage transactions tailored to the client's financial situation and objectives;
- Conduct transactions rigorously and provide high-quality after-sales service;
- Pass the AMF certification exams, including multiple-choice questions, and prepare for the mandatory 12-week probationary period after successfully passing the exams.



Project Management

The ACS in Project Management prepares graduates for a variety of roles, such as:

- Project Coordinator
- Assistant Project Manager
- Junior Project Manager
- Project Management Administrative Assistant
- Administrative Supervisor
- Project Management Technician

Languages and Duration

This program is offered in French and English. The training consists of **1,065 hours**, including a 255-hour internship, delivered over five consecutive semesters.

The Project Management program is designed for individuals who wish to develop applied expertise in planning, executing, monitoring, and closing projects across a variety of sectors. This comprehensive program allows participants to acquire technical and professional skills that meet current labour market standards, in both the private and public sectors.

Structured around specialized courses and a workplace internship, the program covers all dimensions of project management: budget planning, risk management, team supervision, quality assurance, and internal controls.

This training leads to an Attestation of College Studies (ACS) recognized by the ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur. It is offered in French and English.

The program aims to train competent and versatile project managers able to:

- Plan and organize all phases of a project effectively;
- Manage costs, resources, risks, and timelines;
- Implement integrated quality management methods;
- Lead multidisciplinary teams and resolve conflicts;
- Ensure monitoring and internal control of activities;
- Communicate clearly and professionally with all stakeholders;
- Contribute to achieving the organization's strategic objectives.



Residential Real Estate Brokerage

(EEC.21)

Attestation of College Studies (ACS)

Career Opportunities



The Residential Real Estate Brokerage ACS directly prepares graduates for professional practice regulated by the Organisme d'autoréglementation du courtage immobilier du Québec (OACIQ). Completing the ACS and passing the certification exams are required to obtain a residential real estate broker's licence. Graduates may work independently or within licensed real estate brokerage agencies.

Languages and Duration

This program is offered in French and English. The total duration of the program is **450 hours**.

The Residential Real Estate Brokerage (EEC.21) program is designed for individuals who wish to acquire the knowledge, skills, and professional ethics required to practice as a residential real estate broker in Québec. This program is fully aligned with the requirements of the Organisme d'autoréglementation du courtage immobilier du Québec (OACIQ), which regulates the profession and defines certification standards.

The program emphasizes mastering the legal and ethical framework set out by the Real Estate Brokerage Act, acquiring technical skills related to residential real estate transactions, and preparing for the mandatory OACIQ certification exams.

This training is offered in French and English and leads to an Attestation of College Studies (ACS) recognized by the ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur.

The program aims to train competent residential real estate brokers able to:

- Apply the legal and regulatory provisions governing the profession;
- Carry out real estate brokerage activities in compliance with OACIQ rules and the highest ethical standards;
- Accurately draft brokerage contracts and offers to purchase, using the forms required by the OACIQ;
- Prepare effectively for OACIQ certification exams, a mandatory step toward obtaining the residential real estate broker's licence.

Admission Requirements for the Attestation of College Studies (ACS) programs

To be eligible for the program, applicants must meet the general admission requirements set out in Article 4 of the College Education Regulations and the following specific conditions:

A person who has received instruction considered sufficient by the college and meets any of the following conditions may be admitted to a program of studies leading to an Attestation of College Studies:

- 01** The person has interrupted his or her full-time studies or pursued full-time postsecondary studies for at least 2 consecutive terms or 1 school year.
- 02** The person is covered by an agreement entered into between the college and an employer or by a government program of studies;
- 03** The person has interrupted his or her full-time studies for one term and pursued full-time postsecondary studies for one term.
- 04** The person holds a Secondary School Vocational Diploma.

A person who has a Secondary School Diploma and meets either of the following conditions may be admitted to a program of studies leading to an Attestation of College Studies:

- 01** The program of studies enables the person to pursue technical studies in a field for which there is no program of studies leading to a Diploma of College Studies.
- 02** The program of studies is covered by an agreement on training entered into between the Minister and a department or body of the Gouvernement du Québec.

* Specific admission requirements for the LCA.FZ Project Management (ACS) program: Mathematics ST5, NS5, or 526 is required. If you have not completed this course, you will be able to take it during the first semester of your program with us.

* To be eligible for graduation and the awarding of an Attestation of College Studies (ACS), students must meet the French language requirements established by the Charter of the French Language.



Commercial Real Estate Brokerage (EEC.2C)

Institutional Certificate of Achievement

The Commercial Real Estate Brokerage (EEC.2C) program is a short-term specialization designed for individuals who wish to acquire the specific skills required to practice as a commercial real estate broker in Québec.

Aligned with the requirements of the Organisme d'autoréglementation du courtage immobilier du Québec (OACIQ), this training enables participants to master the

knowledge and practical skills needed to successfully pass the certification exam leading to the commercial real estate broker's licence.

This program is offered in French and English and leads to an Institutional Certificate of Achievement issued by the Collège Royal du Québec.

** This program is not recognized by the ministère de l'Éducation or the ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur.*

The program aims to:

- Develop the core skills and knowledge required to effectively practice commercial real estate brokerage;
- Enable participants to understand the legal, technical, and financial specifics of commercial transactions;
- Provide a structured and intensive preparation for the OACIQ commercial brokerage certification exam;
- Facilitate a smooth and competent integration into the commercial real estate sector.

Program Content

The program consists of two specialized courses totaling 140 hours.

01 Financial Specificities of Commercial Transactions

- Financial and tax considerations unique to commercial transactions
- Analysis of financial statements and applicable ratios
- Management of commercial financing particularities

02 Drafting Documents Related to Commercial Transactions

- Preparation of contracts and forms specific to commercial brokerage in compliance with Organisme d'autoréglementation du courtage immobilier du Québec (OACIQ) standards
- Legal and contractual obligations
- Case studies and practical exercises

Admission Requirements

To be eligible for this program, applicants must:

Hold an Attestation of College Studies (ACS) in Residential Real Estate Brokerage (EEC.21) issued by the Collège Royal du Québec or equivalent training recognized by the OACIQ.

* Currently, this program is only offered as a specialization in commercial brokerage for individuals who have previously obtained an ACS in Residential Real Estate Brokerage.



Career Opportunities

The Institutional Certificate of Achievement allows graduates to register for the OACIQ certification exam, which is a prerequisite for obtaining a commercial real estate broker's licence.

Graduates may subsequently work as commercial real estate brokers. These professionals typically practice within licensed real estate brokerage agencies or operate independently as self-employed brokers.



Languages and Duration

The total duration is 140 hours, delivered in one full-time semester or through various part-time schedules. Courses are offered in French and English, with options adapted to adult learners (daytime, evening, or weekends).



Residential and Commercial Drafting (5750)

Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS)

The Residential and Commercial Drafting (5750) program is designed for individuals who wish to acquire specialized skills in designing architectural and technical plans in residential, commercial, and industrial settings. This comprehensive program develops the ability to produce detailed plans using computer-aided drafting (CAD) software, in compliance with current standards and the instructions of architects and engineers.

This stimulating field requires precision, attention to detail, autonomy, and a solid understanding of geometric and technical principles.

The training leads to a Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS) issued by the ministère de l'Éducation and is available in both French and English.

The program aims to:

- Acquire the knowledge, skills, and attitudes needed to produce precise technical drawings;
- Perform on-site surveys and gather relevant technical information;
- Determine material quantities and prepare basic estimates;
- Master the use of drafting software and specialized digital tools;
- Design architectural, structural (concrete and steel), and building systems (ventilation, plumbing, electricity) plans;
- Develop the ability to create complete plans for residential and commercial buildings.

Admission Requirements for the Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS)

To be eligible for admission to this program, candidates must meet one of the following requirements:

Persons holding a Secondary School Diploma or its recognized equivalent, for example, an Attestation of Equivalence of Secondary V studies, or a postsecondary diploma such as the Diploma of College Studies or a Bachelor's degree

or

Persons who are at least 16 years of age on September 30 of the school year in which their training is to begin and have earned the Secondary IV credits in language of instruction, second language and mathematics in the programs of study established by the Minister, or have been granted recognition for equivalent learning.

or

Persons who are at least 18 years of age upon entry into the program and have the following functional prerequisites: the successful completion of the General Development Test (see the following table), or recognition of equivalent learning

or

Persons who have obtained Secondary III credits in language of instruction, second language and mathematics in programs established by the Minister are required to pursue general education courses, concurrently with their vocational training, in order to obtain the Secondary IV credits they lack in language of instruction, second language and mathematics in programs established by the Minister.



Career Opportunities


This profession is ideal for individuals who demonstrate :

- A strong interest in drawing and precision
- Skills in calculation and geometry
- Resourcefulness and autonomy



Languages and Duration

This program is offered in French and English, full-time over approximately 19 months and includes a 120-hour workplace internship.



Ontario Secondary School Diploma

(OSSD)

The OSSD is a certification recognized across Canada and internationally, allowing eligible students to obtain an Ontario high school diploma.

To earn this diploma, students must have completed the equivalent of Grade 11 (or Secondary 5 in Quebec), obtain validation of their transcript and academic record by our Registrar, complete six pre-university courses in one of the three available streams (Science,

Business, or Liberal Arts), and complete between 10 and 40 hours of community service, depending on their previous academic level.

Additionally, students must successfully complete the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Course and Examination to be awarded the diploma.



Grades 7 to 12 Curriculum
